#### SOUTH LEICESTER MG CLUB CHARITIES NOMINATED FOR 2024

Below is a summary of our nominated charities for 2024. The winning charity is the one we will support this year.

The Clubs AGM will be held on Tuesday 6<sup>th</sup> February at 20.00 and members attending will be asked to vote from the following:-

#### **GEMS**

GEMS is Leicestershire charity run solely by volunteers who raise funds with the aim 'To help patients and their supporters who visit the Chemotherapy Suite in the Osborne Building at the Leicester Royal Infirmary more comfortable during their treatment'. The charity was founded in 2012 by Andy and Sally Anderson who supported 4 close friends through their cancer treatment. The name of the charity is taken from the initial letters of those friends: Gilly, Elizabeth, Meg and Sarah.

Chemotherapy often requires patients to sit for several hours at a time to receive treatment which can be incredibly uncomfortable and GEMS aim to make the environment for the patients and supporters more comfortable during their treatment. They won the Pride of Britain Regional Fundraiser Award in 2021 and have funded the refurbished of the waiting room and the balcony at the Chemotherapy Suite and provided comfortable treatment chairs.

#### JOE HUMPHRIES MEMORIAL TRUST

The Joe Humphries Memorial Trust has been set up to draw attention to a little known condition called SADS – Sudden Arrhythmic Death Syndrome - which happens when the heart stops beating unexpectedly due to an abnormal rhythm. This generally happens to younger people and children who did not know they had a heart problem. When someone suffers an 'arrhythmia' the muscles of the heart beat so chaotically that there is no pulse and no blood pressure which means no blood to the head and vital organs and the person will pass out within as little as 30 seconds and die within minutes. There are 30,000 such cases in the UK annually and less than 1 in 10 survive. Immediate CPR and defibrillation can increase the chance of survival to over 50%.

The Trust work with East Midlands Ambulance Service and Leicester Public Health to:

- a) Identify gaps in the coverage of defibrillators around the county so that more can be placed where needed to increase accessibility
- b) Run courses in life saving skills and use of a defibrillator through an education programme in the community.

#### LEICESTER MUSICAL MEMORY BOX

Leicester Musical Memory Box is a not for profit organisation delivering fun and interactive sessions through the use of singing, music and gentle seated exercises to help improve health and well-being whilst reducing loneliness and social isolation and believe that music is an essential part of life. Initially sessions were set up for people living with dementia and memory loss but now open the sessions to anyone who feels they may benefit. Sessions are led by Kyle Newman and Christina Birkby along with their team of volunteers. They also have Geet Sangeet groups led by Beena Masand for the South Asian community.

Sessions are offered at 3 locations in the county including Broughton Astley Village Hall.

#### **BROUGHTON ASTLEY VOLUNTEER GROUP**

The Broughton Astley Volunteer Group was set up in March 2020 just as the country was going into its first COVID lockdown. The aim was to support the local community by improving the well-being of vulnerable or isolated individuals during what was, to many, a frightening time. An appeal made to residents attracted 200 volunteers and these were employed to help with Prescription collection, local shopping, dog walking and friendly phone calls. Today the aims are still the same but with the addition of creating local social groups to benefit the well-being of Broughton Astley residents. They became a registered charity in October 2020 and are now able to apply for grants and raise funds to enable this work to continue.

The Group is managed by Mark Barber, Jenny Row, Nicola Clegg and Jan Briggs from their office in Broughton Astley Village Hall




